About the Speaker



Prof. S. Mahendra Dev is currently Director and Vice Chancellor at Indira Gandhi Institute of Development Research (IGIDR), Mumbai. He was Chairman of the Commission for Agricultural Costs and Prices for the Ministry of Agriculture of the Government of India. He is Vice Chairman of the Board of Trustees of International Food Policy Research Institute (IFPRI), Washington, D.C. He was member and Acting Chairman of the National Statistical Commission, Government of India.

He got the prestigious Malcolm Adisesaiah Award in 2016. He was Director of Centre for Economic and Social Studies in Hyderabad. Professor Dev has more than 200 research publications in national and international journals. He has written or edited 19 books. Oxford University Press has recently published his book "Inclusive Growth in India". He has been a consultant and adviser to many international organizations and a member of several government committees including the Prime Minister's Task Force on Employment and Rangarajan Commission on Financial Inclusion.

Brief Sketch of Dr. Waheeduddin Khan



Dr. Waheeduddin Khan (1934-85) was one of the Founder Members of the Centre for Economic and Social Studies and was first appointed its Honorary Director in 1980 and joined as its full-time Director in May, 1982. He held this position till January 6, 1985, when he suddenly expired. Dr. Waheeduddin Khan, besides serving on the Task Force and various other Advisory Committees of Planning Commission of India, also served on several Technical and Advisory Committees of the

Central Government and State Government of Andhra Pradesh. He had an impressive published academic record which includes (5) books, (8) Reports, (28) Papers and (7) Research Studies. Some of his important works are: "Metropolitan Hyderabad and its Region" (1982), "Integrated Area Development Plan for Pauri-Garhwal District, U.P." (1976), "Problems in the Management of Minor Irrigation Schemes" (1978), "Study of Costs and Benefits of Rural Electrification in A.P." (1980) and "Case Study on Criteria for Technological Choice Decision in Indian Agriculture" (1981).
