The post Congress will be held on October 25-26, 2023
and is hosted by Department of Anthropology, University of Hyderabad, India in collaboration with Tribal Cultural Research and Training Institute (TCR & TI), Government of Telangana, Department of Liberal Arts, Indian Institute of Technology-Hyderabad, Department of Sociology, Maulana Azad National Urdu University, Hyderabad, Tata Institute of Social Sciences, Hyderabad, Centre for Economic and Social Studies (CESS), Hyderabad and Council for Social Development (CSD), Hyderabad.

*The theme of the Post Congress is ‘**Anthropology and Digital Culture**’. ([Click here for concept note](#)). The Post congress will be held in physical mode. However, the request of foreign scholars for online participation may be considered.*

***Panel proposals** are welcome on any discourse, debate and reflections that resonate with the theme of the Post Congress. Panels will be open to accepting papers from conference participants and the responsibility of selection of papers and inclusivity will lie with the panel convenors. Scholars interested to propose panels may note the following time lines:*

Open date for panel submission: August 07, 2023

Close date for panels: September 15, 2023

Intimation of acceptance of panels: By September 18, 2023

Guidelines for submission of panels

Proposals have to be submitted online through the conference website. Maximum two proposals will be accepted per person. Convenor (or at least one, if more than one Convenor) must hold a Ph.D. at the time of proposal submission. All proposals must be in English.

Panel proposals should submit an abstract of about 300 words along with details of Chair and Co-Chair. Each panel must have a minimum of four papers.

Registration fees:

All participants desiring to present papers / float panels should complete the registration process online within the timelines specified. Registration involves submission of a registration form and payment of registration fees. The registration entitles: a) Free access to all onsite scientific sessions of the Congress. b) Congress materials and soft copy of the Book of Abstract. c) High tea after inauguration; d) Working lunch on both days of conference; e) Conference kit e) Free entry to cultural event; and f) Certificate of participation

Registration amount includes 18% GST (Govt. of India regulations). Bank charges will be additional as per mode of payment.

Note: Apart from Inaugural and Valedictory sessions, the Post Congress will have only 18-24 panels (64-96 papers).
